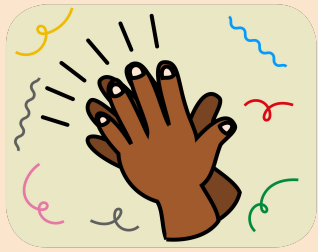

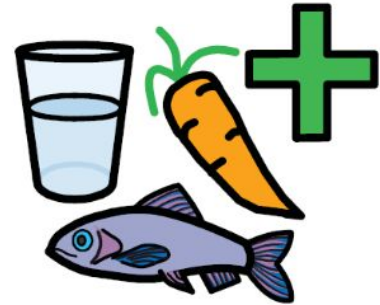

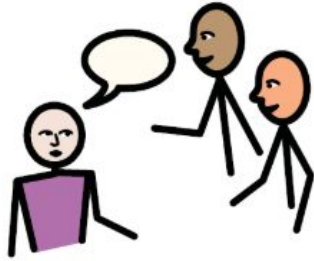
Our Learning for World Environment Day

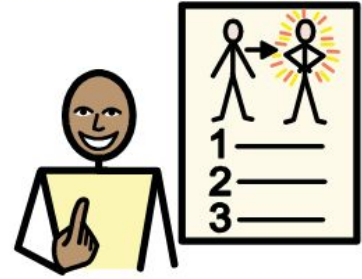

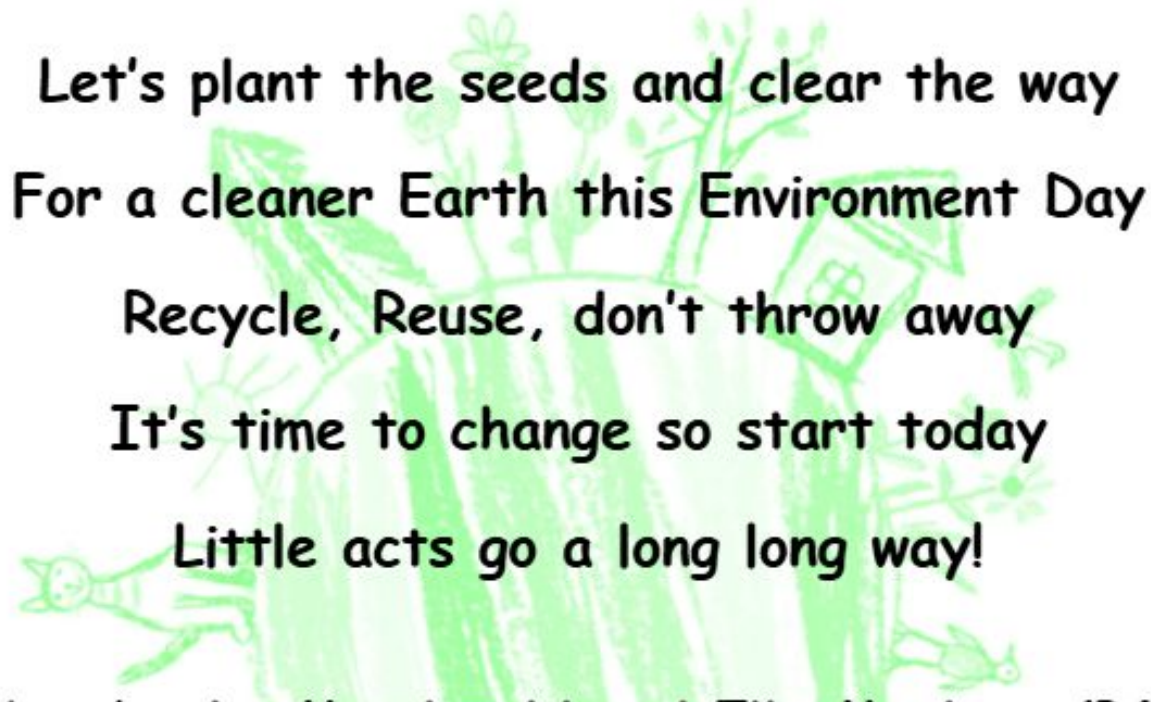

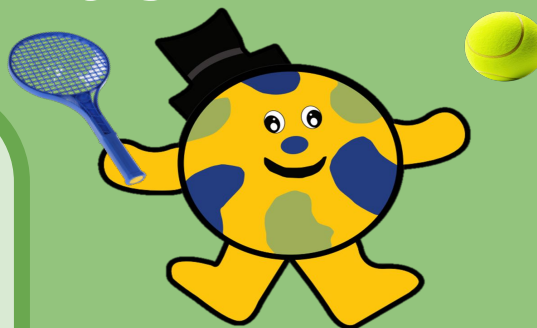
Our Playground Charter
